


# 2018 Virginia Law Enforcement Torch Run Routes Region 4: Southside

Each summer, law enforcement officials from across Virginia carry the Flame of Hope on a 1,900 mile journey to the Special Olympics Virginia Summer Games Opening Ceremony in Richmond.

This 8-day Torch Run involves more than 2,000 law enforcement officers and personnel representing more than 200 law enforcement agencies across Virginia.

In Southside Virginia (Region 4) Torch Run Route legs in Emporia, Prince George, Ft. Lee, Petersburg, and Colonial Heights take place over several days during the week of June 4th.


