



## 2018 Virginia Law Enforcement Torch Run Routes Region 5: Central Virginia

Each summer, law enforcement officials from across Virginia carry the Flame of Hope on a 1,900 mile journey to the Special Olympics Virginia Summer Games Opening Ceremony in Richmond.

This 8-day Torch Run involves more than 2,000 law enforcement officers and personnel representing more than 200 law enforcement agencies across Virginia.

***In Central Virginia (Region 5) Torch Run Routes in Chesterfield County, Hanover County, and New Kent County converge in Henrico County and then continue on to Richmond City.***

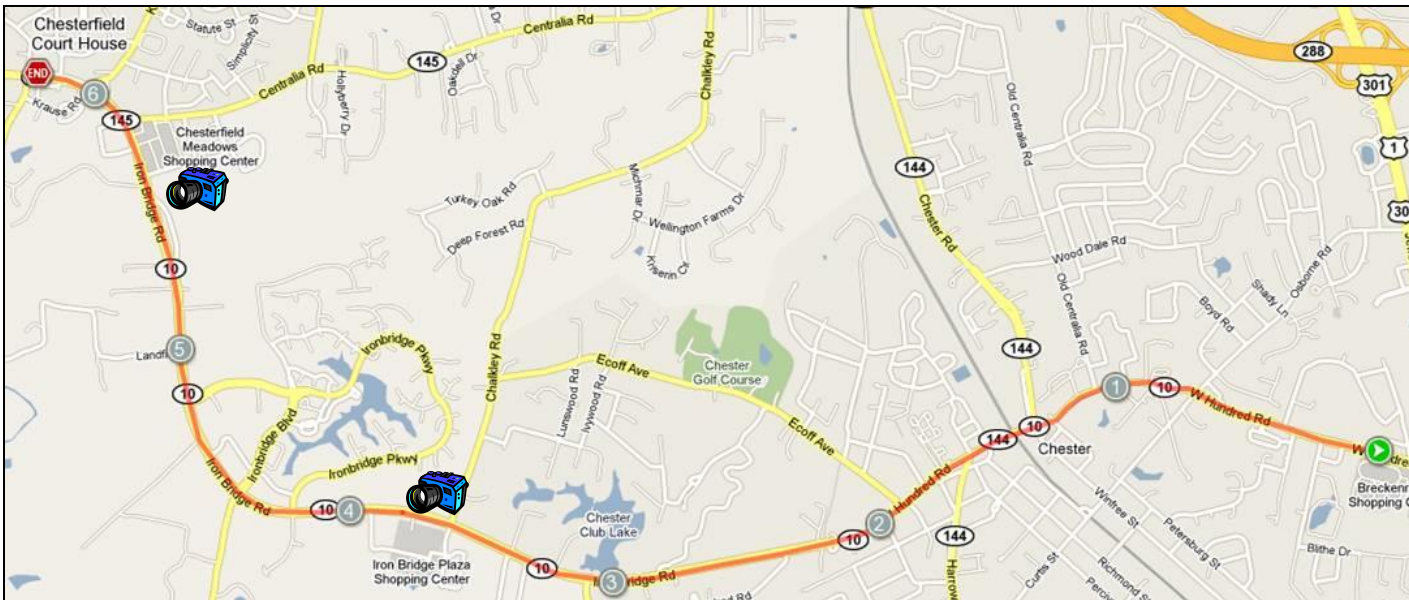

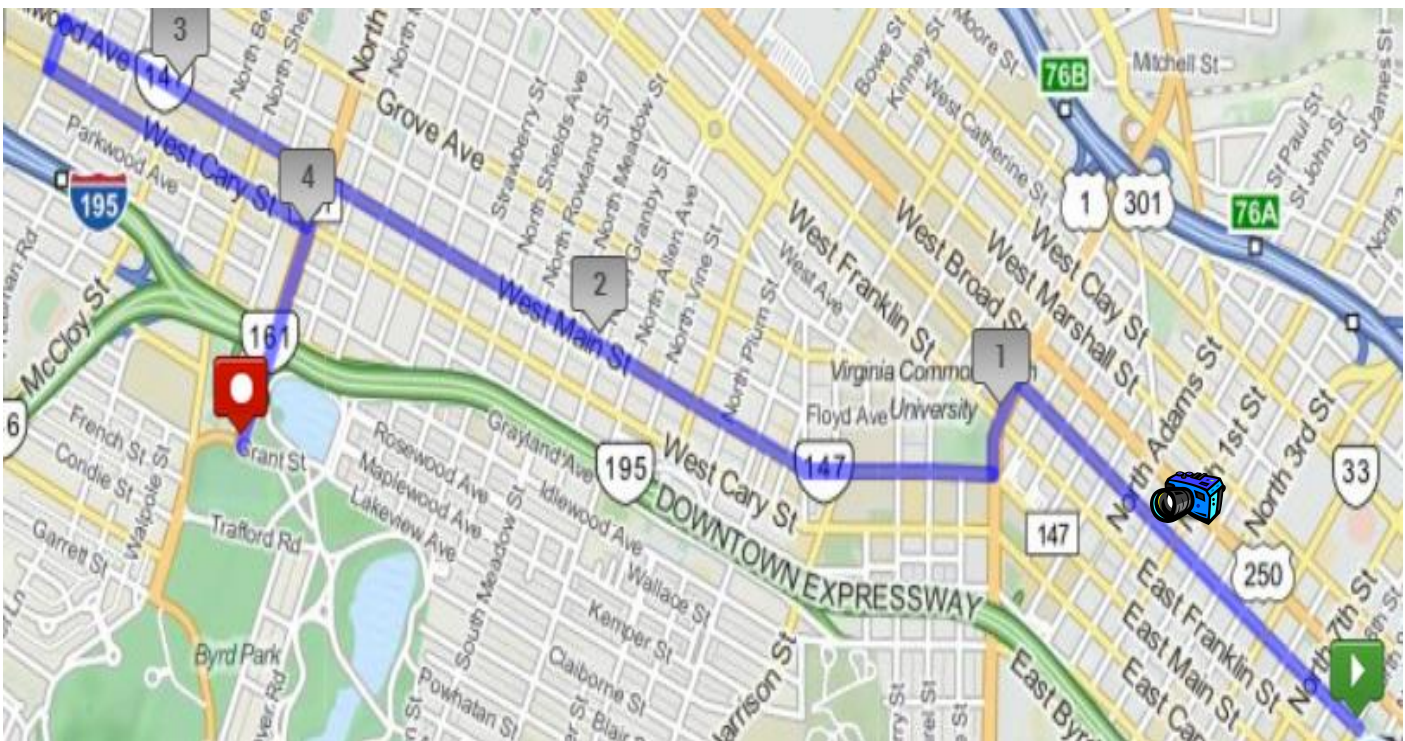

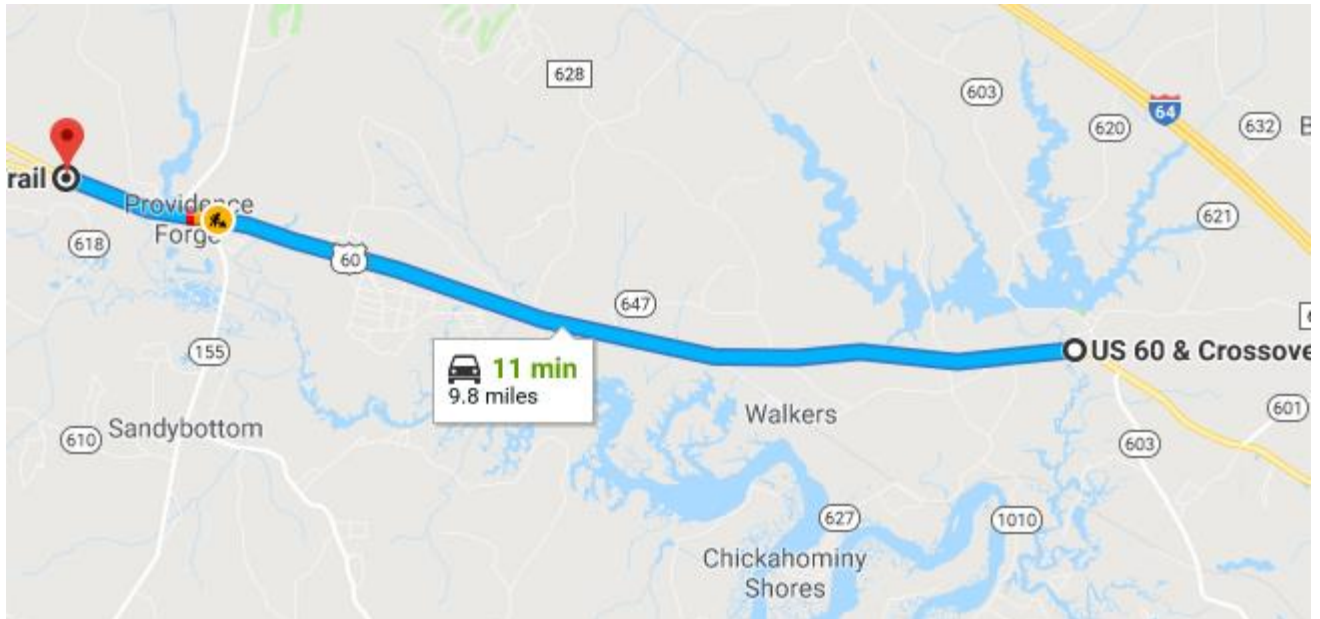
